The City of Chula Vista is seeking a qualified undergraduate or graduate student to assist in the busy Office of Communications. This internship will provide valuable work experience that will prepare you for a career in communications after graduation. The position is available now and we are seeking someone to work approximately 20 hours a week through June 30, 2017 (and potentially beyond). You will learn a range of communications skills: event planning, social media, marketing, community outreach, promotions, advertising, and more. The ideal candidate has experience or is pursuing a degree in communications and/or marketing, has an interest in municipal government or non-profit, thrives in a creative teamwork environment, is a quick and eager learner, and has excellent computer and writing skills.

Work assignments will be varied and could include the following tasks:

- Assist with event planning for large-scale festivals and events
- Assist with social media program including developing content for Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram
- Assist with review and updating web content
- Assist with writing assignments including flyers, brochures, and other materials
- Assist with monitoring and compiling metrics for press coverage, marketing programs, and public outreach efforts
- Assist with review of media contacts and identify additional media outlets
- Assist with developing photo library for web and social media

Hourly rate: \$12.12 - \$13.33/hour depending on schooling completed (undergraduate or graduate). The work schedule can be set between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. – Monday through Thursday; and 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Friday. There will be occasional night and/or weekend assignments for City special events.
