## Instructions for Searching and Navigating within the Screening Maps

The VMT per Resident and VMT per Employee screening maps are used to determine if a project may be screened as described in Section 3.3 of the TSG. Methods for viewing data and navigating the web map tool are described below.

**Settings and Layers.** The screening maps are best displayed using Google Chrome and the display setting for your computer monitor should be at 100%. The default display has all layers turned on. You can turn layers on an off clicking on the layer list button in the upper right-hand corner of the window. Other buttons in the upper right corner allow you to toggle the layer display and change the base map layer.



**Property Search.** Type the property address into the search field in the upper left corner of the window as shown to the right. Press the magnifying glass to search. If no property address has been assigned, you can click on the map to display the data for the specified location.



**Data Display.** After pressing the magnifying glass, you will be taken to a zoomed-in view of the property, and a window will indicate the number of search results for the property. Press the right arrow button on the upper right corner of the window to cycle through the search results, which will indicate the property's VMT per Resident or per Employee and whether or not the



property is within a Transit Priority Area or a High-Quality Transit Corridor.
