CULTURE-DEFINED

- A SYSTEM OR BEHAVIOR THAT HELPS US ACT IN AN ACCEPTED OR FAMILIAR WAY.
- SYSTEMS CAN BE A FAMILY, BUSINESS, GROUPS OR SUB-GROUPS (AN INDIVIDUAL).
- LEADERSHIP ESTABLISHES A POLICING CULTURE FOR THREE PRIMARY REASONS:
 - 1. SO THAT WE'LL KNOW WHAT'S EXPECTED OF US.
 - 2. SO THAT WE'LL KNOW WHEN WE HAVE DEVIATED.
 - 3. SO THAT THE COMMUNITY KNOWS WHAT TO EXPECT.

What are the three (3) parts of the Constitution?

- **1. Preamble-** We the people...
- 2. Articles- There are seven articles which, among other things, establish our three branches of government (Legislative, Executive and Judicial) and rules for how future amendments to the Constitution should be made.
- 3. Amendments-
 - A. The first 10 amendments are called- *Bill of Rights*
 - **B.** There have been 27 amendments made to date.

LAW ENFORCEMENT CODE OF ETHICS

As a law enforcement officer, my fundamental duty is to serve the community; to safeguard lives and property; to protect the innocent against deception, the weak against oppression or intimidation and the peaceful against violence or disorder; and to respect the constitutional rights of all to liberty, equality and justice.

I will keep my private life unsullied as an example to all and will behave in a manner that does not bring discredit to me or to my agency. I will maintain courageous calm in the face of danger, scorn or ridicule; develop self-restraint; and be constantly mindful of the welfare of others. Honest in thought and deed both in my personal and official life, I will be exemplary in obeying the law and the regulations of my department. Whatever I see or hear of a confidential nature or that is confided to me in my official capacity will be kept ever secret unless revelation is necessary in the performance of my duty.

I will never act officiously or permit personal feelings, prejudices, political beliefs, aspirations, animosities or friendships to influence my decisions. With no compromise for crime and with relentless prosecution of criminals, I will enforce the law courteously and appropriately without fear or favor, malice or ill will, never employing unnecessary force or violence and never accepting gratuities.

I recognize the badge of my office as a symbol of public faith, and I accept it as a public trust to be held so long as I am true to the ethics of police service. I will never engage in acts of corruption or bribery, nor will I condone such acts by other police officers. I will cooperate with all legally authorized agencies and their representatives in the pursuit of justice.

I know that I alone am responsible for my own standard of professional performance and will take every reasonable opportunity to enhance and improve my level of knowledge and competence.

I will constantly strive to achieve these objectives and ideals, dedicating myself before God to my chosen profession . . . law enforcement.

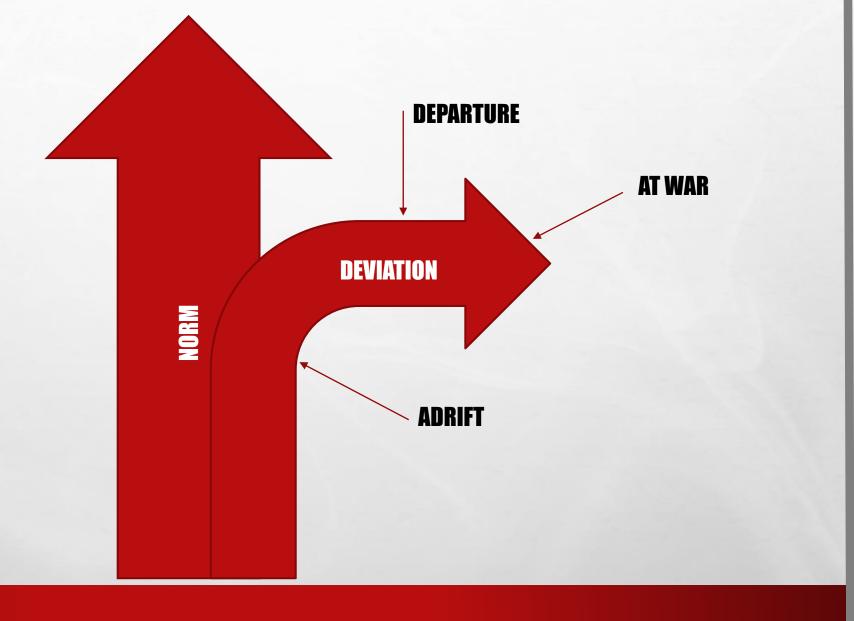

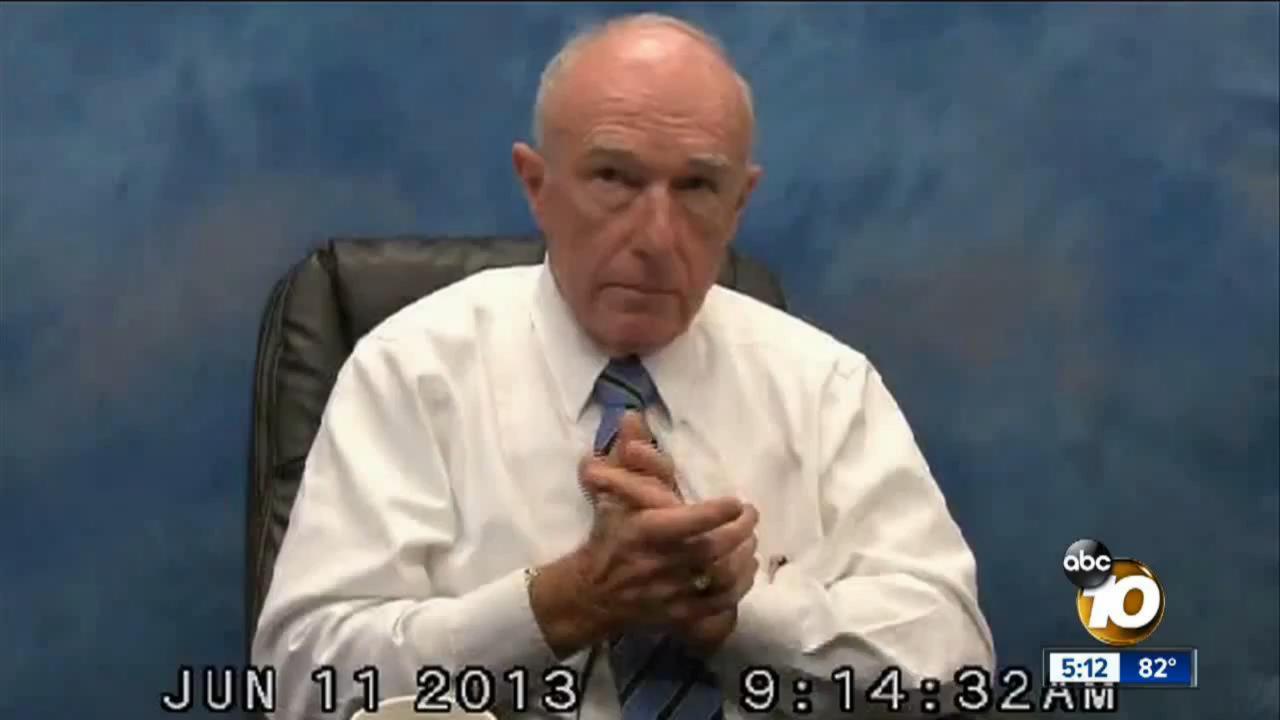
