Subject: Assault with a Deadly Weapon - One victim shot (AM-PM 700 Block of E Street)

On Thursday, April 15, 2021, at 12:29 AM, officers responded to a radio call of a shooting that took place in the parking lot of AM-PM located at 700 Block of E Street in Chula Vista. When officers arrived on scene, they located the victim, identified as Gustavo Briseno (19-years-old). Briseno suffered two gunshot wounds to both legs and was transported to a local area hospital with believed non-life-threatening injuries.

Officers attempted to interview Briseno who provided little information regarding what led to the shooting or the suspect(s) who shot him. Based on store security video, officers determined the passenger of an unknown vehicle, believed to be a blue or black 4-door Honda sedan, exited the vehicle and shot at the victim striking him in the legs. Store security video also shows Briseno appear to make hand gestures, potentially gang signs, at the occupants of the Honda prior to the shooting. Based on the store security video the shooting appears to be gang related.

The suspect(s) are currently outstanding, and no description is available at this time. The Chula Vista Police Department is currently trying to locate witnesses and potential suspect(s) to this incident. Anyone who may have any information regarding this incident is asked to please contact San Diego County Crime Stoppers at 888-580-8477.

We are actively investigating the incident and we appreciate your patience since we do not expect to have any further updates on the case today. We will provide further information in a subsequent advisory when it becomes available.
