On Thursday, July 8th, at approximately 10:18 PM, officers from the Chula Vista Police Department responded to a radio call reference a victim shot outside of a residence located in the 1100 block of Bellena Avenue in Chula Vista. When officers arrived at the scene, they located a victim, later identified as Osvaldo Robledo (38-years-old) suffering from a single gunshot wound to his neck. Robledo was transported to a local area hospital and remained in stable condition until passing away this morning due to injuries sustained from the gunshot wound.

The investigation is still on-going but has been able to determine the victim Robledo and the suspect David Flores (57-years-old) are acquaintances and knew each other before the shooting. On July 8th, Robledo and Flores had a property dispute that escalated into an argument outside the residence. During the argument, Flores pulled out a gun and shot the victim one time. Flores left the scene prior to officers arriving and it is believed he fled to Mexico.

A picture of Flores has been attached with the press release and an arrest warrant has also been issued for Flores. The Chula Vista Police Department is currently trying to locate Flores and any witnesses to this incident. We are actively investigating the incident and we appreciate your patience since we do not expect to have any further updates on the case today. We will provide further information in a subsequent advisory when it becomes available.
