SYNOPSIS:

Officers were dispatched to a call of a neighbor disturbance. After speaking with the reporting party/victim, officers learned the reporting party was a victim of an ADW. Officers attempted to contact the suspect at a separate address. Upon entry into the suspect's residence the suspect attacked one officer with a knife, stabbing him multiple times. That officer pulled his duty weapon, and shot the suspect, stopping the threat. Both the officer and suspect were transported to different hospitals for treatment. The suspect was subsequently pronounced deceased. The Officer is expected to survive his injuries.

While speaking with [REDACTED] officers learned he had been struck in his upper body by a piece of concrete that had been thrown over the fence. [REDACTED]
[REDACTED] The size of the concrete piece was described as about the size of a large grapefruit.

[REDACTED]

Officers SACHS and BANALES approached the home with the intention of speaking to the suspect. At the time, Officer BANALES had the department [REDACTED] with him as a ride-along.

When they arrived at the front door, Officer SACHS knocked. A woman, [REDACTED], answered the door. Officers explained the nature of their visit. [REDACTED] told officers her adult son, DAVID JOSEPH SCOTT (DOB [REDACTED]-89), was inside the home and she invited the officers inside.

Officer SACHS entered first with Officer BANALES and [REDACTED] following closely behind. As soon as they entered the home, DAVID SCOTT came around the corner from within the home and charged Officer SACHS while holding, what was described as a steak knife. DAVID SCOTT began stabbing Officer SACHS, striking him in his face, right arm, and the back of his head. Officer SACHS yelled out that DAVID was armed with a knife, while at the same time drawing his duty firearm and firing it at DAVID approximately four times. DAVID was struck and went down to the floor.

Officers retreated to the front yard where Officer SACHS began receiving first aid [REDACTED]
[REDACTED]. Fire department and Emergency Medical personnel responded, along with additional police officers.

Upon further investigation officers found DAVID inside the home on the living room floor. He was moaning and somewhat conscious at the time, and subsequently transported to [REDACTED]. DAVID ultimately succumbed to the gunshot wounds and was pronounced deceased at approximately 2329 hours.

Officer SACHS was transported to [REDACTED] where he remained conscious and was treated and stabilized [REDACTED]. Officers secured the SCOTT residence for homicide investigators to respond.

I arrived on scene with other homicide investigators at approximately 2357 hours. We conducted a scene briefing and then I participated in a scene walk through with Officer BANALES. For specific details regarding the walk-through refer to Det. MOLINA's scene report.

REPORT NARRATIVE

On 9-19-17 at approximately 2225 hours, I was assigned to a radio call regarding a pregnant female trying to stab someone with a knife. I was on foot on the west side of Hilltop Park.

I heard dispatch say they went Emergency Traffic on channel three. I switched my radio to channel three and heard someone say that shots had been fired and an officer had been stabbed. I got into my vehicle, activated my lights and sirens and drove to **Monterey Ave** where Officer L. Banales and Officer D. Sachs were supposed to be.

I arrived on scene and saw multiple police vehicles already on scene and driving to the address. I parked my vehicle and began walking up towards the house. Officer Sachs came out of the house and walked towards me. **Officer Sachs was wearing just his undershirt; he had removed his vest and outer uniform shirt. He had a tourniquet on his arm above his elbow crease.** I told Officer Sachs the time of the tourniquet.

Officer Sachs told me he left his duty weapon at the scene and that it needed to be secured. I located the gun in the driveway on top of a barrier wall next to his vest that was on the ground. The gun's muzzle was facing east. The gun had blood on it but appeared not to be damaged. The slide was forward and did not appear to be jammed. The magazine was seated properly. I did not count the rounds in the gun. At that time I did not know the gun had been fired. The scene was not secure and there were many people nearby. I removed the magazine from the weapon and then seized the bullet that was in the chamber and placed it in my pocket. I brought the weapon and magazine down to my vehicle to secure it. The weapon and bullet were placed in separate paper bags. I was later told it was possibly the weapon involved with the shooting. Officer M. Carmona stayed with the weapon and bullet. He placed them in paper bags and kept them on the hood of my patrol vehicle.

I went back towards the house. I heard someone say they needed compression dressing for the suspect. I went back to my vehicle and got my medical kit. The medics had arrived so I left the medical gear outside of the house.

Officer M. Carmona and I cut Officer Sach's shirt off his body. He was transported to **Officer Carmona kept a log of the outer scene. He was called to the Crimes Of Violence briefing and I took over the log. I was relieved from the log by Officer C. Valdivia. This concluded my involvement with the investigation.**

I saw an object lying in the road on Monterey approximately 15 feet west of the northeast corner of James at Monterey. I retrieved it with an ungloved hand to prevent it from being run over and discovered it to be the nameplate for Officer D. Sachs (1184). I placed the item in a paper bag and gave it to Officer N. Valdivia (1096) who was inside the scene for addition to the evidence collection inventory.

I saw three male figures silhouetted by emergency lights standing near the southeast corner of the driveway. I then realized Officer Banales stood facing the residence with his duty weapon pointed at the open door.

This was an uncertain, tense and rapidly evolving situation that may still have a combative suspect with a weapon.

I don't recall who told me but heard someone say there was one female inside the residence with the suspect and she was the suspect's mother.

I knew Officers were still in an exposed location and told them we needed to move behind my vehicle. I kept my rifle pointed at the residence as we moved incase the suspect exited the residence with a weapon. We held this position until additional units arrived. K9 Agent D. Clark arrived on scene and we moved towards the front door. Agent Clark gave verbal commands to the female to exit the residence so we could help the shot suspect. An elderly female quickly complied and exited.

Officers formed a line at the front door before entering the residence. It consisted of Agent Clark first, then myself followed by Officers T. McAtee, K9 Officer T. Wall and Officer R. Yates. I do not know the order in which Officer McAtee, Wall and Yates entered the home. The entrance to the home was extremely narrow, and had a zig-zag like layout to the right where the kitchen and an open area past that. The suspect was face down on the floor in the open area past the kitchen. Officers announced ourselves and moved towards him. The suspect rolled onto his back and I could clearly see he was no longer holding a weapon. We moved towards him and Officer McAtee rendered first aide while Officer Yates and I continued past him to clear the home.

[REDACTED] Officer Yates and I moved past him to a long hallway at the far side of the room. This hallway was also narrow and poorly lit. We cleared approximately two to four rooms and determined no one else was in the residence.

On 9/19/17 at approximately 2228 hours, I responded to Melrose Street after hearing an officer airing that shots had been fired and an officer had been stabbed. Officer Valdivia and I responded to the scene code three. When I arrived on scene, I observed the mother of the suspect, exiting the front of the house. stated something to the effect of, he's dying in there. I then grabbed by the hand and helped her step down from the retaining wall. I directed to go to Officer Valdivia's location several cars away. I then observed several officers preparing to make entry into the house, so I joined the officers and made entry into the house. I cleared the first room to the south or left as you walk into the door which checked negative. I heard Agent Clark identifying stating he was observing a male, later identified as David Scott, lying on the living room bleeding. Agent Clark stepped to the side to give space for myself and Officers Wall, Yates and Arnold to make contact with the Scott laying on the floor. We then entered the living room area. I began rendering first aid to Scott. I cut off his shirt and began looking for signs of trauma.

I then conducted a quick sweep of Scott's extremities looking for further signs of trauma which I did not find. I asked Scott what had happened. He was not able to give me any verbal statement.

While rendering aid to Scott I observed 4 bullet casings in close proximity to each other near the left or south side of the piano. A cell phone, which I assumed was Scott's was located near his feet. While exiting the house, I observed a kitchen knife on the floor to the right or south of the refrigerator.

Medics arrived on scene and began treating Scott. They then placed him on a backboard and transported him to the hospital.

I then exited the house and remained in the vicinity until I was cleared to leave by my supervisor.

I have no further information at this time.

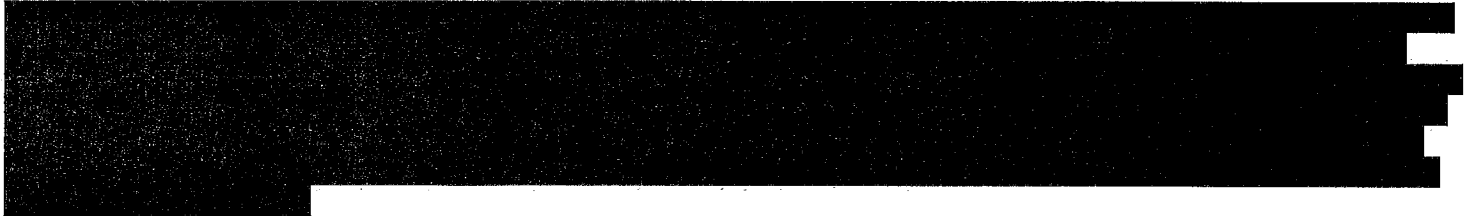

On 9-19-17 at about 2128 hours, Officer Lawrence and I were at the Chula Vista Animal Shelter when we heard Officer Banales advise shots were fired and an officer was stabbed at **Monterey Avenue**. We responded with emergency lights and sirens and arrived on scene at approximately 2232 hours. Officer Lawrence and I moved patrol vehicles out of the roadway in the 700 block of Monterey Avenue for emergency medical vehicles.

At this time, Lt. Peak directed me to AMR unit 420 and asked me to take photographs of Officer D. Sachs. I entered the back of the ambulance and took digital photographs of Officer Sachs. Officer Lawrence and I then followed Officer Sachs and AMR unit 420 to **Monterey Avenue**.

While at the hospital, I took additional digital photographs of Officer Sachs injuries before and after he received medical treatment from **Monterey Avenue**. Officer Sachs had the following visible injuries.



Monterey Avenue I did not see any other visible injuries on Officer Sachs at this time. For additional details on his injuries pre and post treatment, please refer to my evidence photographs.

Medical staff removed Officer Sachs' blood stained clothing including his uniform boots, uniform pants, uniform belt, socks, underwear, shirt stays, watch, wedding band and tourniquet (on right arm). **Monterey Avenue** placed those items into two paper bags and I took custody of them inside the trauma room. This concluded our assistance at **Monterey Avenue**.

At about 0140 hours, Officer Lawrence and I returned to CVPD and I took digital photographs of Officer Sachs blood stained clothing and personal effects in the CVPD property room. I returned the items to their respective paper bags and kept them with me.

At about 0415 hours, I spoke with Crimes of Violence Detective Alvarez. He told me to place Officer Sachs' blood stained clothing and personal effects into a drying room and give him the key. At about 0420 hours, I secured the items in CVPD property drying room #1 and gave the key to Detective Alvarez.

I later uploaded 74 digital photographs into the Veripic server. This concluded my participation in this investigation.

During my regular patrol duties, I heard a report of an Officer Involved Shooting at [REDACTED] Monterey Ave, in the City of Chula Vista. I responded with my lights and sirens activated from the CVPD station.

When I arrived on scene, I saw Officer Sachs (#1184) standing in the middle of the street covered in blood. Officer Sachs was not wearing a vest or uniform shirt at this time. He had on a black T-shirt, his duty belt, and his patrol pants. [REDACTED] I cut Officer Sachs' T-shirt off to check for additional wounds. The following are the observations I noted regarding Officer Sachs' wounds:

As I was checking Officer Sachs' injuries, [REDACTED] CVFD arrived on scene shortly after and were able to render aid.

After Officer Sachs was transported to the hospital, I was then instructed to start an "outer crime scene log." All subjects who entered the area were accounted for. Additionally, I placed Officer Sachs' shirt in an evidence bag. Officer Hicks also handed me his duty belt and patrol service weapon. Officer Hicks advised me he had cleared the weapon and made it safe. He had the bullet, which was in the chamber, in his pocket. I took possession of all the items and bagged them as evidence. I later handed the crime scene log and evidence over to Officer Hicks and cleared from the scene.

The front door of the residence was wide open. I observed an elderly white woman, screaming as she was bent over her son who had been shot several times during the altercation. Officer Clark made announcements and called her out of the residence to safety. [REDACTED]

Officers' Clark, Arnold, and I made entry into the house. The suspect was laying on is back face up. There were large pools of blood surrounding the suspect to include a cellphone and a large beach towel. As we made entry into the main living room where the suspect was located two officers attempted to locate the weapon, a knife. Unable at the time to find the weapon officers attempted to render aid to the suspect. Officer G. Arnold and I were directed by officer Clark to clear the residence to ensure there were no additional threats.

Once the residence was cleared medical aid was clear to enter the residence. Medics and fire entered and rendered aid to the suspect. As I stood by I observed 4 small caliber shell casings near the west wall of the residence in the living room. On 09/19/2017, at approximately 2230 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] Monterey Avenue on a report of an Officer who was just stabbed and fired shots at his attacker. I responded from the 800 block of Hilltop Drive and was one of the first Officer's to respond on scene. When I arrived the first thing I noticed was Officer D. Sachs #1184 standing in front of a parked patrol car, and his face was covered in blood. I retrieved my police K9 "Turbo" from the back of my vehicle and approached Officers who had taken up a position facing the open front door of [REDACTED] Monterey Avenue. The Officers informed me that the suspect in question, later identified as David Scott (DOB [REDACTED] 89), was still inside the residence lying on the floor near the front door. I initially took up a position toward the corner of the driveway where I could look into the open door. From my position I could see an elderly female kneeling over what appeared to be an injured and bleeding Scott.

At that point I could hear the female screaming, and I did not know if she was being attacked or just in distress over Scott's injuries. At that point I decided to yell into the residence in an attempt to have the female exit. I did this so we could keep her safe, and begin the process of rendering aid to Scott, who we had perceived based on initial information, had been shot multiple times. I yelled out, addressed her as "mom", and told her to come outside so we could help David. After a couple of shouts inside, the female, later identified as [REDACTED] came outside yelling for us to help. After [REDACTED] was out of the residence, I moved a little closer and could see that Scott was lying a large pool of blood. [REDACTED]. At that point I yelled inside for Scott to stay down on the ground and don't move. I repeated over and over that we wanted to help him and to not move.

As I kept an eye on Scott and his position, I led a small react team up the driveway toward the house. I kept Scott in my sights at all times and kept giving him verbal commands to stay down and that we were coming to help him. [REDACTED]. At one point Scott rolled over onto his back, and I had an unobstructed view of his hands and torso. Myself and my react team entered the residence and held in a small hallway while we assessed Scott further. It was my opinion that Scott was gravely injured and we needed to make the scene safe, render available aid, and wait for responding paramedics. Officer Mcatee assisted by rendering the immediate area around Scott safe, and conducting an initial assessment of his injuries.

Within a few minutes CVPD fire engine company #59 arrived on scene and assisted with medical aid.

At that point I exited the residence and secured my K9 partner back in my vehicle.

At approximately 2242 hours I walked over to [REDACTED] to see if she would be willing to go to the station for questioning. [REDACTED]

I later uploaded my BWC footage to Evidence.com.

I cleared the scene at approximately 0250 hours on 09/20/2017.

I am a Detective with the Chula Vista Police Department (CVPD), Criminal Investigations Division (CID) assigned to the Crimes of Violence (COV) Homicide Unit. I have worked in this specific unit since November 2015. I have been a detective and worked in investigational units for almost 5 years and have been a sworn police officer for almost 13 years.

On Tuesday September 19, 2017 at approximately 2242 hours, I received notification from Sergeant Oyos (ID 752) regarding an Officer Involved Shooting (OIS). Sergeant Oyos told me Officer David Sachs (ID 1184) was stabbed multiple times by the suspect during the OIS. I was directed to meet at the CID COV area with other COV Homicide detectives who were called to respond as well. I arrived at the CID area at approximately 2320 hours. I met with Detective Molina (ID 840) and Detective Sharpe (ID 809).

The OIS occurred at [redacted] Monterey Avenue in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego. Due to the type of incident, a "Command Post" was established at the Chula Vista Community Church located at 301 East J Street in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego. At approximately 2350 hours, Detectives Sharpe, Molina, and I drove to the Command Post. Detective Alvarez (ID 743) arrived a short time later. Sergeant Oyos was present along with members from the CVPD Command Staff and Professional Standards Unit (PSU). Detective Sharpe was assigned as the "Case Agent" and Detective Molina was assigned as the "Scene Agent". I was assigned to assist Forensic Specialists (FS) Venn (ID 1044) and [redacted] during scene processing and evidence collection.

On Wednesday September 20, 2017 at approximately 0110 hours, Detectives from COV, along with the Patrol Division, PSU, and other investigative units initiated a formal briefing. During the briefing, Patrol Sergeants and Patrol Officers who responded to the OIS described their involvement and observations. For further details, please see the "Scene Report" by Detective Molina and the audio recording.

During the briefing, I learned the following: The OIS occurred inside [redacted] Monterey Avenue. The suspect was identified as David Joseph SCOTT ([redacted]/1989). SCOTT was transported to [redacted] located at [redacted] in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego. SCOTT was pronounced dead at the hospital at 2329 hours. Officer Sachs was transported to [redacted] in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego. Officers Sachs and Banales (ID 534) initially responded to a radio call of a disturbance between neighbors at [redacted] Melrose Avenue in the City of Chula Vista, County of San Diego. During their investigation, they determined an assault with a deadly weapon occurred and the suspect resided at [redacted] Monterey Avenue. Officer Banales had [redacted] assigned to him. The OIS occurred at [redacted] Monterey Avenue during their contact with the suspect.

Venn collected a piece of concrete, which was approximately the size of a softball, and a wooden stick, which was approximately one-inch round and three feet in length.

At approximately 0410 hours, FS Venn, [REDACTED] and I went to [REDACTED] I first met with Medical Examiner Investigator (MEI) [REDACTED] outside the Emergency Room (ER). At approximately 0512 hours, FS Venn, [REDACTED] and I went to [REDACTED] to collect evidence from Officer Sachs. FS Venn photographed most of Officer Sachs' injuries. She was unable to photograph some of the injuries due to the medical bandages. FS Venn also collected a mouth DNA sample. FS Venn kept custody of the evidence. [REDACTED]

At approximately 0630 hours, FS Venn, [REDACTED] and I went back to [REDACTED] Monterey Avenue. FS Venn first photographed the driveway of the property. Later in the morning, Sergeant Oyos informed me the Search Warrant for the residence was signed. FS Venn then photographed the inside of the residence. After the photographs, we waited for other COV Detectives for the execution of the search warrant. We did not search for evidence.

At approximately 0800 hours, Sergeant Oyos directed me to attend SCOTT's autopsy with FS Garber (ID 947). FS Garber and I drove to the San Diego County Medical Examiner's Office located at 5570 Overland Avenue # 101 in the City of San Diego, County of San Diego. [REDACTED] performed the autopsy.

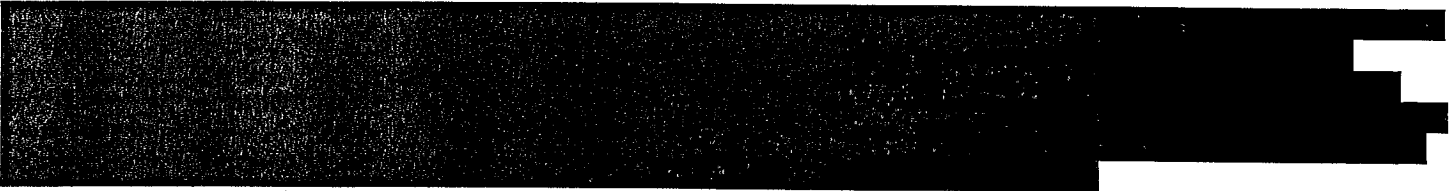
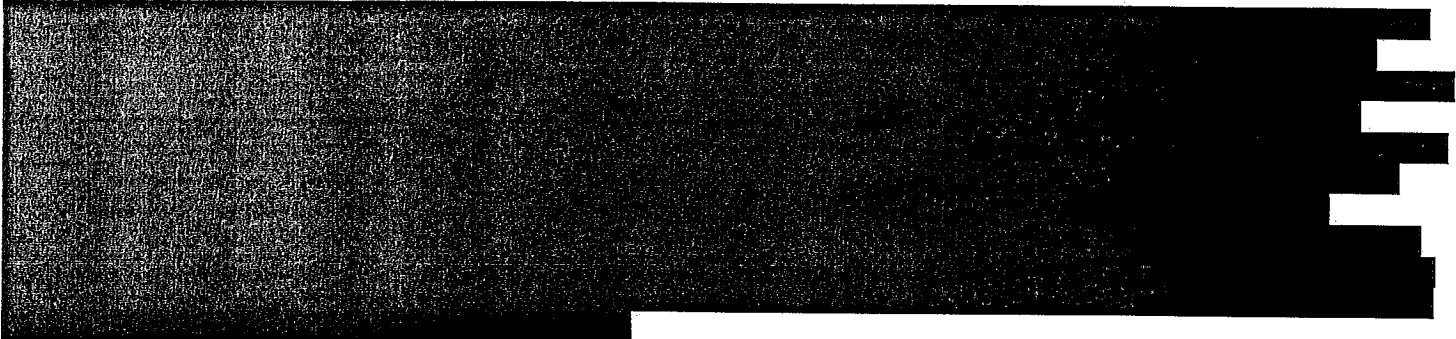

I am a detective assigned to the Chula Vista Police Department (CVPD), Criminal Investigations Division (CID), Crimes of Violence Homicide Unit (COV). I have worked in this specific unit for a total of 23 months. I am currently assigned as one of the COV gang detectives and I am also one of two "Gun-Desk" Detectives.

On 20 September 2017 at approximately 2242 hours I received notification from my direct supervisor, Sergeant (Sgt.) D. OYOS (ID#752), regarding an Officer Involved Shooting that occurred at [REDACTED] Monterey Ave, Chula Vista, CA. 91910. I was directed to meet at the Command Post (CP), which had been established on the [REDACTED] J Street. I was to meet with other COV detectives who were called to respond as well. I arrived at the CP at approximately 0000 hours and met with other detectives from my unit.

At the CP Sgt. OYOS assigned the following roles for this investigation: Detective (Det.) S. Sharpe (ID# 809) - Case Agent; Det. A. MOLINA (ID# 840) - Scene Agent; Det. J. MONREAL (ID# 905) - Assisting Agent; and I was also assigned as an Assisting Agent.

At 0110 hours, we began the formal scene briefing, which was initiated by Sgt. OYOS. Sgt. S. ADKINS read from the incident briefing script. For further details of the briefing please review the Scene Report completed by Det. MOLINA.

The following is a summary of what I learned from the briefing; On 19 September 2017, at approximately 2059 hours, the CVPD dispatch center received a call [REDACTED]. This call for service was not dispatched until 2157 hours. Officers L. BANALES (ID#534) and D. SACHS (ID# 1184) responded. Officer BANALES had [REDACTED] riding along with him.

BANALES and SACHS met with the Reporting Party (R/P) [REDACTED]

The officers rang the doorbell. Officer SACHS stood to one side of the door, while Officer BANALES and [REDACTED] stood to the other side and waited. The door was answered by the suspects mother [REDACTED]. The officers told her why they were there [REDACTED]. She invited the officers into the residence to speak with her son. The entry way into the house was very narrow only allowing one officer at a time through the door and toward the right into the kitchen area and dining room. [REDACTED] called to her son and almost immediately he was in the kitchen physically attacking Officer SACHS. The suspect was identified to us as David Joseph SCOTT. I learned Officer SACHS initially thought the suspect was punching him and then quickly realized he had been stabbed numerous times. Officer SACHS and SCOTT fell to the ground inside the kitchen. Officer SACHS got to his feet, moved away from SCOTT, and retrieved his duty firearm from its holster. The suspect got up and again rushed at officer SACHS. Officer SACHS fired his duty weapon at SCOTT, striking him. It was believed Officer SACHS fired four or five rounds at SCOTT.

SCOTT fell to the ground in the dining room area of the house and Officer SACHS exited the house to find help for his injuries. The officers broadcast the shooting on the radio and numerous other officers responded to the scene to assist.

I found [REDACTED] and Officers MUROFUSHI and VALDIVIA. She was leaning against a retaining wall and was very calm and collected. She was pleasant to speak with. Detective SHARPE and I introduced ourselves to [REDACTED] and she was willing to accompany Officers MUROFUSHI and VALDIVIA back to the CVPD for interview. I then returned to the Command Post and the next process was to conduct a detective "Walk-through" of the scene.

Myself, the other COV detectives and Sergeant and a few other law enforcement officials were taken on the walk-through of the scene by Officer BANALES. We walked along the east sidewalk across the street from the scene. We passed the scene toward the south. We then put on protective booties over our shoes. We then crossed the street toward the house south of [REDACTED] Monterey Ave. We were very cautious not to disturb any potential evidence. We met with the officer controlling the scene log and checked in. In pairs we entered under the crime scene tape and cautiously approached the scene. I was one of the first two to enter the scene. I only walked to the front door of the house. At the time, I did not enter the scene. I only looked in from the open front door. I listened to Officer BANALES as he described what we were looking at. I could see a large area of blood on the floor of the room next to the kitchen area. I saw lots of blood spatter on the front door and throughout the driveway. I saw Officer SACHS vest carrier lying on the ground of the driveway. It was covered in blood.

On 9/19/17 at approximately 2228 hours, I responded to [REDACTED] Melrose Street after hearing an officer airing that shots had been fired and an officer had been stabbed. Officer Yates and I responded to the scene code three, my AXON body camera was activated as I drove to the scene. When I arrived on scene, I observed Officer Arnold pointing his department issued rifle at the open front door to the residence. He told me the suspect, later identified as David Scott, was laying in the living room and the suspect's mother was still inside the residence.

Agent Clark, Officer Yates, Officer Mcatee, Officer Arnold and I set up outside the residence and prepared to make entry into the house. First; we called the suspect's mother out of the residence. She complied and Officer Valdivia took her to a safe location away from the house. The rest of us made entry into the house. Officer Mcatee and I cleared the first room to the south or left as you walk into the door which checked negative. I heard Agent Clark state he observed a male, later identified as David Scott, lying on the living room [REDACTED].

Agent Clark stepped to the side to give space for myself and Officers Mcatee, Yates and Arnold to make contact with the Scott lying on the floor. We then entered the living room area. I began rendering first aid to Scott. [REDACTED]

[REDACTED] I asked Scott what had happened. He was not able to give me any verbal statement.

While rendering aid to Scott I observed 4 bullet casings in close proximity to each other near the left or south side of the piano. I also observed a kitchen knife on the floor to the right or south of the refrigerator.

Medics arrived on scene and began treating Scott. They then placed him on a backboard and transported him to the hospital.

I then exited the house and remained on the perimeter until I was cleared to leave by my supervisor.

I have no further information at this time.

On 09/19/17 at approximately 2215 hours, I was working as the acting Sergeant in full Chula Vista police uniform and driving a marked Chula Vista police vehicle. I was monitoring Chula Vista Police Department dispatch channel and heard Officer Banales say shots fired and an officer stabbed. Dispatch immediately went to emergency traffic and requested police units to respond to Monterrey, Chula Vista. I activated my overhead emergency light and sirens and responded from Club View Terrace and 'L' St, Chula Vista. I did not know the nature of the radio call that Officer Sachs and Banales had responded. Much later I learned the true nature of the radio call.

I arrived with K9 Agent D. Clark at the scene and saw Officer G. Arnold standing with his patrol rifle pointed at the door of Monterrey. I also saw Officer Banales, along with another officer who I initially did not recognize standing on the south east corner of the driveway approximately a foot from the sidewalk. I did not initially recognize the officer because his face and the top part of his uniform was covered in blood, I later recognized the officer as D. Sachs. I could see that Officer Banales and were tending to Officer D. Sach's wounds. So I told Officer Banales and to move Sachs behind cover, which they moved Officer Sachs behind a police vehicle.

Agent D. Clark told me he could hear screaming from inside the house. As Agent Clark moved closer to the door, he told me he could see a male, later identified as David SCOTT, lying on the ground; next to that male was an older female who was screaming to help her son. I later learned the male lying on the ground was the suspect and the older female was the suspect's mom, later identified as. Agent D. Clark, Officer McAtee, Officer G. Arnold, Officer Yates and I formed into a line to enter the house and render first aid to David. As we began to walk towards the front door of the house, I directed Agent Clark to have come out of the house, she complied with our requests. (Please see Officer Valdivia's report). We then entered the residence to render first aid to David and see if any other victims or suspects were still located inside the house.

As I entered the house, I saw David was lying face down on the kitchen floor with his feet towards the front door. I could clearly see David was not armed, however, we still did not know if anyone else was either injured in the house or there was another suspect(s) in the house. I directed officers to continue to search the house for either suspects or victims. While officers searched the house, I saw Officer McAtee cut off David's shirt and roll him over looking for wounds. I waited a few moments for officers to finish clearing the house and when it was reported to me the house was clear I radioed it was clear for fire and paramedics to come into the house, so they could render first aid to David.

I then walked outside and began directing officers to set up a crime scene and directed Officer J. Garcia to start a crime scene log (Please see Officer J. Garcia's report). I also radioed that I needed an Agent to respond to the scene to photograph the scene. Agent Murgia responded and began to photograph the scene. (Please see Agent Murgia's report) I noticed that the Fire Department and paramedics had not entered the house; I began walking down towards the members of the fire department and yelled for them to come into the house to assist. Several members of the fire department responded and entered the house to assist with treatment. David was later transported by ambulance to the hospital. Lt peak arrived and placed me in charge of the outer crime scene. I remained in charge of the outer crime scene until I was directed by Sgt. Oyo to open up that scene.

As I approached the crime scene, I noticed Officer Sachs and Officer Banales standing next to a patrol vehicle. [REDACTED]

I took a safety statement from Officer Sachs regarding the shots fired. I asked Sachs how many shots he fired. Sachs said, "I heard four." I asked what direction he fired the shots. Officer Sachs pointed east and said, "Whatever that way is." I asked if they were outside and Sachs said they were inside the house. Officer Banales told me when they cleared the threshold of the residence, "He was on us." Banales said the suspect was stabbing. [REDACTED]. Medics arrived a few minutes later.

Officer Hicks brought over a cleared handgun with no magazine inserted. He told me he cleared the weapon. I instructed him to place it in a bag with Officer Sachs' belongings. I then instructed Officer Carmona to watch the evidence and ensure the items remained on the vehicle (untouched) until the crime lab arrived.

I then went to the residence located at [REDACTED] Monterey, where the suspect was on the ground in the dining/living room. The suspect was conscious and breathing, and Officer McAtee was monitoring him. [REDACTED]. After checking on the suspect, I went back to the firefighters who were on the street. [REDACTED]. I also asked Officer Zimmer to hold the house for investigations.

I later asked Officer Parks to watch Sachs' bulletproof vest and gear. I also sent Officer Yates to [REDACTED] in San Diego to accompany the suspect in the ambulance. I sent Officer Banales and [REDACTED] to [REDACTED] to be with Officer Sachs.

I am a detective assigned to the Chula Vista Police Department (CVPD), Criminal Investigations Division (CID), Crimes of Violence Homicide Unit (COV). I have worked in this specific unit for approximately 11 months.

On 09/19/17 at approximately 2240 hours, I received a text message from COV Sergeant, D. OYOS (752), informing me that an officer involved shooting occurred and a CVPD officer was stabbed. He advised COV Team 1 was being called out to investigate the incident. COV Team 1 consists of four members from the CVPD COV Unit; Det. MOLINA (840), Det. ALVAREZ (743), Det. MONREAL (905) and myself. Sgt. OYOS told us Officer D. SACHS (1184) was both the shooting officer and the officer who was stabbed by the suspect.

I arrived at CVPD at approximately 2320 hours. Detectives MONREAL and MOLINA arrived at CVPD a short time later. Once at the station I pulled up the 'call for service' log and confirmed the incident occurred at [REDACTED] Monterey Avenue in the City of Chula Vista. The Command Post was set up at [REDACTED] J Street, in the church parking lot, and Sgt. OYOS instructed the COV detectives to meet him there.

Myself, along with Detectives MOLINA and MONREAL, left CVPD and drove entail to the Command Post. We arrived at approximately 2357 hours. Detective ALVAREZ arrived at approximately the same time.

Once at the Command Post we received updated information that Ofc. SACHS was transported to [REDACTED]. The suspect, who was identified as David SCOTT ([REDACTED]/89), was transported to [REDACTED] Hospital [REDACTED] and pronounced deceased by hospital medical staff. SCOTT was positively identified by his mother, [REDACTED], whom he lived with at [REDACTED] Monterey Avenue.

Sgt. OYOS told us [REDACTED] was standing by with Officers VALDIVIA (1096) and MUROFUSHI (1122). [REDACTED] was sitting outside, a couple houses down from her residence with two officers. Det. ALVAREZ and I walked over and introduced ourselves to [REDACTED] and explained the purpose of our role in this investigation. [REDACTED] agreed to speak with us at CVPD. Ofc. MUROFUSHI transported [REDACTED] to CVPD in his patrol vehicle. They waited in a CID conference room for myself and Det. ALVAREZ to finish at the scene.

On 09/20/17 at approximately 0110 hours, the incident brief was conducted by Street Team Sergeant, S. ADKINS (612). CVPD personnel present at the briefing included, but were not limited to, COV Team 1 Detectives, COV Sergeant, D. OYOS, Forensic Specialist VENN (1044), Homicide Relief Team Officers VASQUEZ (975), RUIZ (1057) and GONZALEZ (804), Ofc. BANALES (534), Ofc. VALDIVIA, Patrol Sergeant, D. KENDRICKS (904), and San Diego District Attorney Criminal Investigator, R. LOBATO. The incident brief was audio recorded and a copy was later logged into evidence.

Sgt. ADKINS told us at approximately 2058 hours dispatch received a call of a neighbor disturbance. [REDACTED]

At approximately 2157 hours Officers SACHS and BANALES were dispatched to [REDACTED]. Sgt. ADKINS added that [REDACTED], was riding along with Officer BANALES during the swing watch shift (1400 - 0000 hours).

[REDACTED], made contact at SCOTT's residence (approximately 2225 hours). Sgt. ADKINS stated at approximately 2228 hours Officer BANALES advised over the radio that shots had been fired and Ofc. SACHS was stabbed. Numerous patrol units responded to [REDACTED] Monterey Avenue to assist.

When officers arrived Ofcs. SACHS and BANALES, and [REDACTED], were outside the residence in the driveway. SCOTT was located by officers inside the residence lying on his back on the living room floor. Officers immediately started rendering aid to SCOTT. [REDACTED] was in the living room next to SCOTT when officers arrived.

Ofc. SACHS was transported to [REDACTED] via paramedics (AMR [REDACTED]). Ofc. BANALES and [REDACTED] rode with him in the ambulance. SCOTT was transported to [REDACTED] Hospital via paramedics (AMR [REDACTED]), and Ofc. YATES (1094) rode with him in the ambulance. SCOTT was pronounced deceased at the hospital at 2329 hours.

Sgt. ADKINS advised us of the responsibilities of various officers on scene. Ofc. ZIMMER (1083) was inside the residence securing the interior scene, Ofc. C. PARK (1124) was outside the residence securing the exterior scene, and Ofc. CARMONA (1165) was overseeing Ofc. SACHS' property that was removed from him while officers were rendering aid. For specific details regarding the actions of officers on scene refer to the respective officers' supplemental reports.

After Sgt. ADKINS completed his initial brief, Ofc. BANALES provided his incident brief. Ofc. BANALES told us he and Ofc. SACHS, along with [REDACTED], spoke with the reporting party/victim, [REDACTED] at his residence ([REDACTED] Melrose Ave.).

[REDACTED] showed them the "concrete chunk" SCOTT threw at him and pointed to the house from where it was thrown. Officers drove to the residence [REDACTED] pointed out, [REDACTED] Monterey Avenue. Ofc. BANALES stated he was on the right side of the front door, Ofc. SACHS was on the left side of the front door, and [REDACTED] was standing behind them when Ofc. BANALES knocked on the door.

SCOTT's mom [REDACTED] answered the door and Ofc. SACHS explained to her why they were there. [REDACTED]

Ofc. SACHS entered the residence first and Ofc. BANALES said he followed in behind Ofc. SACHS with Chaplain ANDERSON behind him. As they entered the foyer area Ofc. BANALES said, "The suspect ambushed SACHS." SCOTT struck Ofc. SACHS multiple times, but Ofc. BANALES initially thought SCOTT and SACHS were just fighting with their hands. Ofc. SACHS "knocked the suspect down" and simultaneously Ofc. BANALES heard Ofc. SACHS yell, "Knife!"

Ofc. BANALES said he and [REDACTED] retreated out of the house and then heard approximately 4-5-gun shots from inside the residence. Immediately after hearing the gun shots he saw Ofc. SACHS exit the residence covered in blood. SCOTT did not exit the residence. Ofc. BANALES stated he notified dispatch via the radio shots had been fired and then rendered first aid to Ofc. SACHS until other officers arrived.

After Ofc. BANALES finished speaking, Sgt. KENDRICKS provided a brief. Sgt. KENDRICKS said when he arrived on scene officers were making entry into SCOTT's residence to locate him. He observed Ofcs. SACHS, BANALES and [REDACTED] standing next to a vehicle. [REDACTED]

Sgt. KENDRICKS asked "Safety Statement" questions including, how many shots were fired and in what direction. Sgt. KENDRICKS said Ofc. N. HICKS (1132) rendered Ofc. SACHS' firearm "safe" and placed it with his police uniform clothing on top of a marked police vehicle. Sgt. KENDRICKS assigned Ofc. CARMONA (1165) to oversee that evidence. That evidence was later turned over to Forensic Specialist VENN.

Sgt. KENDRICKS entered SCOTT's residence and observed SCOTT lying on the kitchen floor. Ofcs. WALL (1065) and McATEE (1101) were rendering first aid to SCOTT. [REDACTED] He advised CV Fire personnel that SCOTT needed immediate medical attention. SCOTT's clothing was subsequently cut off and later collected as evidence by Forensic Specialist VENN. SCOTT was eventually transported to [REDACTED] and Sgt. KENDRICKS instructed Ofc. YATES to ride in the ambulance with him.

Ofc. J. GARCIA (1207) was assigned to maintain the scene log which was later logged into evidence by Forensic Specialist VENN. Agt. MURGIA (787) took preliminary photographs of SCOTT and the inside of SCOTT's residence. Those photos were later uploaded to the VeriPic database.

After Sgt. KENDRICKS finished his brief, Ofc. VALDIVIA briefed us. He stated when he arrived on scene he heard officers making announcements, telling the suspect not to move. As officers were giving announcements, a white female adult [REDACTED] came out of the residence screaming. Ofc. VALDIVIA took custody of her and asked her what happened.

Ofc. VALDIVIA told us Agt. RACINE (866) was with Ofc. SACHS at [REDACTED] Hospital and took preliminary photographs of him. Those photos were later uploaded to The VeriPic database. Ofc. VALDIVIA stated Ofc. McATEE attempted to get a statement from SCOTT but was unable to do so due to his condition.

For specific details regarding each of the incident brief statements, refer to the respective supplemental reports, and audio recordings,

The brief finished at approximately 0142 hours. COV detectives then participated in a walkthrough of SCOTT's residence with Ofc. BANALES. For details regarding the walk through refer to Ofc. MOLINA's scene report.

Ofcs. VASQUEZ and RUIZ re-interviewed [REDACTED] at his residence. The interview was recorded on BWC and later uploaded to Evidence.com. For specific details regarding [REDACTED] statement, refer to RUIZ's supplemental report and verbatim transcription attached.

On 09/20/17, after the walk through was complete, Det. ALVAREZ returned to CVPD to interview [REDACTED]. The interview took place in a non-secured interview room within CID. The interview was recorded (audio/visual) and a copy was later logged into evidence by Forensic Specialist VENN.

On 09/20/17 at approximately 0731 hours, COV detectives along with Forensic Specialist VENN, executed a search warrant (#55379) at SCOTT's residence (Melrose Ave.). Among the items collected as evidence were four (4) 9mm firearm casings located in the dining room near the piano, a knife with an approximate 5" blade found in the kitchen next to the refrigerator, multiple electronics (cell phones/tablet/i-pod), and a sample of concrete rock located in SCOTT's backyard which matched the concrete chunk thrown at [REDACTED]. For a complete list of items collected as evidence please refer to Det. MOLINA's scene report and Forensic Specialist VENN's lab report.

On 09/20/17 at approximately 0900 hours, the autopsy for SCOTT was completed at the San Diego Medical Examiner's office by Fellow SNYDER, overseen by Dr. MARZOUK. Det. MONREAL and Forensic Specialist GARBER attended the autopsy.

On 09/22/17 COV Detectives Petray (820) and GARDEA (1021) called and spoke with various Fire and EMT personnel who responded to the scene and performed medical aid on Ofc. SACHS and SCOTT. For details regarding their statements refer to Detective PETRAY's and GARDEA's respective supplemental reports and verbatim transcriptions attached.

On 09/25/17 at approximately 0830 hours, Det. MOLINA and I interviewed Ofc. SACHS at CVPD. Ofc. SACHS' attorney, [REDACTED], was also present during the interview. The interview occurred in an interview room within the Criminal Investigations Division and was recorded with the consent of Ofc. SACHS. A copy of the interview was later logged into evidence. The following is a summary of the statement by Ofc. SACHS. For further details refer to the recording and verbatim transcription attached.

Prior to speaking with us, Ofc SACHS and [REDACTED] reviewed Ofc. SACHS' body worn camera footage from the night of the shooting. I confirmed that Ofc. SACHS was speaking with us voluntarily and explained that at any point in time, if he needed a break or wanted to leave, we would stop the interview.

Ofc. SACHS has been a Peace Officer with CVPD for approximately 1.5 years. [REDACTED] Ofc. SACHS said he was currently assigned to Team 2, which works 1400-midnight Monday through Thursday. Ofc. SACHS stated he did not work one specific beat/sector. He explained the assigned Sergeants liked to move officers throughout the City, so everyone was familiar with all three sectors.

On 09/19/17 he was assigned to Sector One which incorporates the portion of the City west of the 805 freeway and north of L Street. Ofc. SACHS could not recall the exact time they were dispatched but said he and one of his beat partners, Ofc. BANALES, were dispatched to a neighbor disturbance call. Riding along with Ofc. BANALES was [REDACTED]

They contacted the Reporting Party [REDACTED] and Ofc. SACHS described him as "jovial and pretty animated." He said the RP did not seem "traumatized" in any way. The RP walked both officers to his backyard and showed them the "chunk of concrete" SCOTT threw at him. Ofc. SACHS said when he saw the concrete block he was thinking, "This is a little more than an argument.... this is more of an attempt 245."

Ofc. SACHS compared the size of the concrete block to that of a large coffee can. He said he was thinking, "The guy must have had a really big hand because I've got pretty big hands and I don't think I'd be winging this thing at anyone. I mean it was that big."

Ofcs. SACHS and BANALES told the RP they would contact the suspect (SCOTT) and would return to let the RP know the outcome. Neither Ofc. SACHS nor Ofc. BANALES had prior contact with the RP or the suspect.

As they drove over to the suspect's house (█ Monterey Ave) Ofc. SACHS said, "We figured we would probably be approaching something of a 110-commit type of call." I asked what gave Ofc. SACHS that impression and he said it was the way the RP described the suspect's conduct; "There was no preceding argument. There was no exchanging of words, just instantly aggressive."

Ofc. SACHS said he and BANALES positioned themselves at the front door, Ofc. BANALES was on the right side and he was on the left side, and Ofc. BANALES knocks on the door then rings the doorbell. There was initially no answer but then Ofc. SACHS said, "I hear this little old lady." Ofc. SACHS identified themselves as 'Chula Vista Police' and she opened the front door. The 'lady' was later identified as █.

█ opened the door and Ofc. SACHS explained the reason they were there. Ofc. SACHS asked if anyone else was in the home and █ said, "█ Ofc. SACHS said, "At this point my gears are shifting" and thought to himself the son (SCOTT) █ and could potentially be violent. Ofc. SACHS explained throughout his patrol experience he had responded to numerous radio calls involving █ subjects who were not taking their █. Based on his experience he knew their behavior could be violent and unpredictable. Ofc. SACHS further stated his experience taught him that these same subjects often █.

█ invited the officers inside to speak with SCOTT and Ofc. SACHS said, "I was thinking I was going to talk him into cuffs and take him to █ I asked what █ demeanor was while she was speaking with them and he said, "She was calm. It was like 'Oh Billy did it again.'"

Ofc. SACHS entered the home first with Ofc. BANALES following in behind him. As Ofc. SACHS stepped into the home he asked █ if her son was violent. █ I asked Ofc. SACHS if his mindset changed at that point and he said, "I didn't have a chance."

█

Ofc. SACHS explained as he entered the home, █ called out to SCOTT and told him the police wanted to speak with him. Ofc. SACHS heard SCOTT respond, "Oh yeah." Based off the tone of SCOTT's voice, Ofc. SACHS said he thought to himself, "Uh-oh."

Ofc. SACHS heard SCOTT before he saw him. Ofc. SACHS said as he turned the corner from the front hallway into the kitchen he paused for a second because, "This guy is coming at me...he almost had a smile on his face. For a split second I flinched, and he just started smashing me in the face." Ofc. SACHS said he stepped back, put his arms up to cover his face and thought, "Jesus Christ!" █ the knife. Ofc. SACHS said SCOTT kept "punching me rapid" and a voice inside his head said, "If you don't fucking move, you're dead." Ofc. SACHS said, "I took everything I had and threw him through the doorway of the kitchen into the kitchen."

Ofc. SACHS explained as SCOTT was falling to the kitchen floor, he was coming over the top of SCOTT to control his arms and place him in handcuffs. When Ofc. SACHS reached for SCOTT's arm he said, "He's just sticking at me and I was like, 'What the fuck? Oh my god!' █

Ofc. SACHS pushed off from SCOTT and screamed, "Knife!" as loud as he could. He stated he yelled 'knife' multiple times so, "My partners wouldn't come in and try and grab him." Ofc. SACHS placed his hand on the kitchen counter and thought to himself, "Okay, I have to go really slow. I have to get my gun out. He's stabbing me, I have to pull out my gun." Ofc. SACHS thought SCOTT was trying to kill him. █

Ofc. SACHS pulled out his gun from his holster and said, "Before I could even get drawn up, he turns around and comes right at me." Ofc. SACHS estimated SCOTT was five feet from him when SCOTT charged at him. Ofc. SACHS was unsure exactly where Ofc. BANALES and [redacted] were. He said, "I thought they might be in the entry way, but I was hoping they weren't because that was my backdrop, and I had no choice but to shoot." I asked where [redacted] was, and he said she was behind him, but he was unsure exactly where.

Ofc. SACHS said SCOTT charged at him, "way more aggressively and more determined than his initial charge at me." Ofc. SACHS fired his gun at SCOTT and SCOTT fell to the ground in the dining room. He estimated he fired 3-4 rounds. Ofc. SACHS heard [redacted] screaming, "Oh my god! What did you do?!" Ofc. SACHS was thinking to himself, "Oh my god, what just happened?" He aired over his police radio, 'shots fired' and gave the address, [redacted] Monterey. He then thought to himself, "I have to get out of the house. [redacted]"

With his gun still out and pointed at SCOTT, Ofc. SACHS walked past SCOTT and out of the house. I asked why he still had his gun out, pointed at SCOTT, and Ofc. SACHS said he wasn't sure if SCOTT was going to get up and attack him again. He said SCOTT was face down and wasn't moving.

Once outside the house, Ofc. SACHS saw [redacted] and Ofc. BANALES in the driveway. [redacted] Ofc. SACHS was telling himself to stay calm and thought, "If I freak out, everyone will freak out. No one will make the right decisions." He still had his gun out pointed back towards the front door. Ofc. SACHS said he was unable to holster his weapon, so [redacted] took it from him and placed it on the brick wall near where they were standing. Ofc. SACHS wasn't sure if his inability to holster his gun was due to his arm injury or adrenaline.

Ofc. SACHS instructed [redacted] to remove his external vest and examine his wounds. [redacted] Ofc. SACHS said, "At one point he was using both hands, but it wasn't working. [redacted]"

As Ofc. BANALES and [redacted] were providing aid to Ofc. SACHS, numerous officers arrived on scene. Ofc. SACHS said, "I just remember feeling, 'Thank God there's other people here.' Those red and blues just really made me feel good."

Ofc. SACHS was transported to [redacted] for further medical treatment. [redacted]

Ofc. BANALES said they contacted the RP [redacted]. The RP took officers to his backyard and showed them the "chunk of concrete" the neighbor threw at him. Ofc. BANALES described it as, "a little bigger than a softball." The RP showed Ofcs. BANALES and SACHS where on the shoulder the concrete chunk hit him. [redacted]

[redacted] Ofc. BANALES told the RP they would check the house and then come back and speak with him. Ofc. BANALES said in his mind he was now investigating an assault with a deadly weapon as opposed to just a neighbor disturbance call.

Ofcs. BANALES and SACHS drove over to [redacted] Monterey Avenue to contact the suspect (SCOTT). I asked Ofc. BANALES if he was familiar with that address and he said no. They walked up to the front door, Ofc. SACHS on the right, Ofc. BANALES on the left and [redacted] was behind them, but unknown exactly where. Ofc. BANALES knocked multiple times before someone finally answered.

A woman [redacted] answered the door and Ofc. SACHS asked her if anyone else was home. [redacted] and Ofc. SACHS explained her son may have been involved in a situation with the rear neighbor. Ofc. BANALES could not remember her exact response, but said something to the effect of, "Oh, he's been ramped up lately. He [redacted] I asked what [redacted] demeanor was like and he said, "She was very calm."

Ofc. BANALES explained her comments "became of concern" to him when [redacted]. I asked Ofc. BANALES what about [redacted] comments concerned him. He explained based on her description of SCOTT's behavior, Ofc. BANALES pictured someone who was [redacted]. Ofc. BANALES explained he has training and experience dealing with mentally ill subjects. He is a PERT Officer (Psychiatric Emergency Response Team) and routinely rides with a clinician. As a PERT Officer his primary responsibility is to respond to calls for service involving mentally ill subjects, evaluate them and, if needed, place them on a police commit. He has also attended several training classes specific to mental illness.

Ofc. BANALES said [redacted] invited them both in and, "Before I could process and get some more information or have him come to us, Dave (Ofc. Sachs) is through the door." As Ofc. SACHS stepped through the threshold of the front door, he asked [redacted] if her son was violent. Ofc. BANALES could not remember what her response was, but Ofc. BANALES' response to what she said was, "Famous last words."

I asked Ofc. BANALES what his mindset was as they entered the house and he said, "There was no reason for any alarms or suspicion that we were walking into something bad or violent." He further stated, "I'm expecting just to talk with someone who maybe is wound up."

Ofc. BANALES described the initial entry area as, "very small." He said, "I'm tall, Officer SACHS is taller than me and [redacted] as tall or taller than me and we were packed in there." As they stepped towards the threshold of the kitchen, Ofc. BANALES said SCOTT came from the back of the house towards the front door. He described SCOTT as, "very tall and very obese."

Ofc. BANALES said, "There was a little scuffle" between SCOTT and Ofc. SACHS near the threshold of the front entry leading into the kitchen. He said, "I thought he was running past us or around us, but all I thought was he pushed or slapped or did something with Officer SACHS and Officer SACHS knocked him to the ground." Ofc. BANALES described the 'fight' between Ofc. SACHS and SCOTT as, "two mountain goats ramming each other."

Ofc. BANALES saw SCOTT land on the kitchen floor and he thought, "We're gonna have to whoop his ass now." Ofc. BANALES leaned forward and was thinking how they were going to gain control of SCOTT and said, "In the back of my mind I heard 'Knife! Knife! Knife! He's got a knife!'"

Ofc. BANALES said he got tunnel vision and his "whole world shrunk to his hand and I see the stupid steak knife. It's like a Sizzler restaurant steak knife." He described seeing the serrated edge and the wooden handle, and thought to himself he needed to create distance. I asked why he thought that and Ofc. BANALES said, "Because if he gets up he's going to be slicing and dicing us."

At this point Ofc. BANALES said he had no idea that Ofc. SACHS was injured, let alone stabbed. Ofc. BANALES said he thought Ofc. SACHS was somewhere in front of him, but he turned his focus to [REDACTED] and getting him to safety.

Ofc. BANALES turned towards the front door and he recalled [REDACTED] being in front of him. Ofc. BANALES repeated that he knew they had to create distance from SCOTT and said, "I don't even get through the front door and 'Bang, bang, bang, bang, bang.'" Ofc. BANALES heard 4-5 shots fired, "in rapid succession." He immediately broadcasted on the radio, "Shots fired."

Ofc. BANALES did not realize Ofc. SACHS was hurt and thought to himself, "Maybe the suspect had a gun. Is David (SACHS) okay?" At about that time, Ofc. SACHS walked out of the house, "calmly as can be," and it was then Ofc. BANALES realized he had been stabbed. Ofc. BANALES said, "I was a little taken aback on how much he was bleeding. [REDACTED] He was seriously injured. He was a mess."

[REDACTED] He walked Ofc. SACHS down the driveway because he was unsure of the suspect's whereabouts. Ofc. BANALES wasn't sure if the suspect was going to come after them or if the mom was going to arm herself and come after them, so he wanted to create distance from the front door. Ofc. BANALES did not hear anything coming from the house and no one else exited the house after Ofc. SACHS did.

Ofc. BANALES did not have a tourniquet on him so he ran to his car, which was parked around the corner, to get one. He was unable to find his tourniquet and grabbed the first-aid kit instead, and brought it back to Ofc. SACHS and [REDACTED]. While they were applying medical aid to Ofc. SACHS, Ofc. BANALES broadcasted over the police radio an officer was stabbed.

Ofc. BANALES said, "It didn't take a lot of time for the cavalry to get there. I heard the sirens and heard guys rushing up." As officers were arriving on scene, Ofc. BANALES broadcasted that the suspect was inside the house and provided a physical description of SCOTT. Ofc. BANALES then further distanced Ofc. SACHS from the house and assisted in removing his vest and gun belt. Eventually paramedics arrived on scene, and Ofc. BANALES rode with Ofc. SACHS in the ambulance to [REDACTED] Hospital.

CVPD Digital Evidence Unit Detective, Agt. STARK (660), forensically downloaded two cell phones pursuant to search warrant #55196. The cell phones (HTC and LG) were originally collected as evidence from SCOTT's residence. I reviewed data from both cell phones and there was nothing of evidentiary value on either of them. The LG phone belonged to [REDACTED] and was subsequently released back to her. The HTC phone belonged to SCOTT and was retained as evidence.

In addition to the cell phones collected, an I-pad and I-pod belonging to SCOTT were also collected as evidence, but were unable to be forensically downloaded due to being password protected. I checked with [REDACTED] but she did not know passwords for either device. The items were retained in evidence.

I spoke with Forensic Specialist VENN regarding the four casings located at SCOTT's residence. The casings matched the ammunition that was in SACHS' magazines. I then confirmed with Det. ALVAREZ, who is a CVPD Range Instructor, that the casings matched the department issued ammunition that is given to sworn personnel.

On 10/03/17 Forensic Specialist VENN took follow-up photographs of Ofc. SACHS' injuries. [REDACTED]

On 11/20/17 I spoke with Kelly HINSLEY, an evidence technician from the San Diego Sheriff's Lab. She told me the blood on the knife which was submitted as evidence matched both Ofc. SACHS and SCOTT. HINSLEY said she would send me a copy of her report when it was complete. On 01/02/18 I called HINSLEY to ask about her report. She said it was under review and she would email me a copy as soon as it was approved by her supervisor. On 01/23/18 the report was received and added to the case file.

On 01/10/18 the autopsy report was received from the Medical Examiner's Office. [REDACTED]

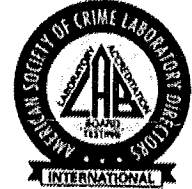

CONCLUSIONS:

Assumed number of contributors: 2 (estimated mixture ratio 90:10)
Extremely strong support for inclusion: David Scott (90% contribution)
David Sachs (10% contribution)

The mixture of DNA obtained from item 9.02 is at least 5.9×10^{30} times more likely if it originated from David Scott and an unknown contributor than if it originated from 2 unknown contributors.

The mixture of DNA obtained from item 9.02 is at least 1.9×10^{20} times more likely if it originated from David Sachs and an unknown contributor than if it originated from 2 unknown contributors.

Any statistics provided for PowerPlex Fusion 6C results do not include the Amelogenin, DYS391, DYS576, or DYS570 loci. All calculations are based on four major U.S. population groups. In each case, the lowest likelihood ratio calculated for any of the populations is reported. Each unknown contributor is assumed to be unrelated to the named contributor(s).

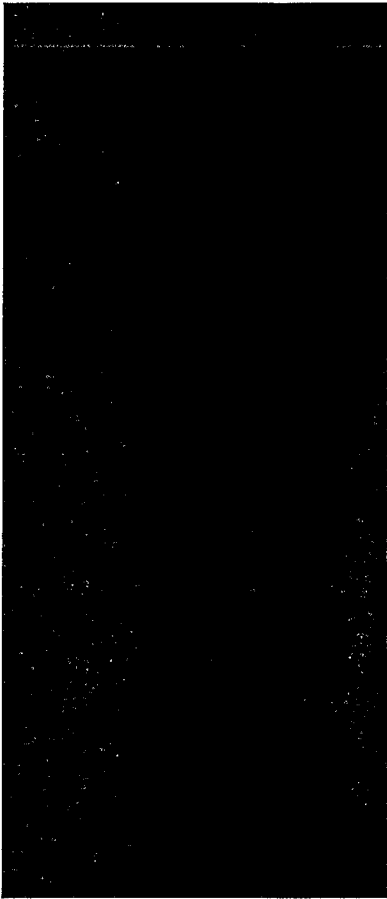
