Subject: Vehicle Pursuit / Domestic Violence – Wanted Suspect Tyler Turner

Message: FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On December 15, 2021 at 4:15 pm, officers from the Chula Vista Police Department attempted to stop a gray 2015 Jeep Patriot in the 1500 block of Yanonali Avenue, Chula Vista. The passenger in the vehicle, identified as Tyler Turner (25-years-old), was wanted for several domestic violence related offenses and child abuse involving an 8-month-old infant.

The driver of the vehicle stopped and exited the vehicle without incident. Turner then proceeded to get into the driver's seat of the vehicle and then drove away. Officers pursued Turner on various surface streets and highways in Chula Vista and San Diego with assistance from the California Highway Patrol and the San Diego Police Department. Officers attempted to utilize intervention techniques to end the pursuit, however Turner continued to flee from police.

Officers eventually stopped pursuing Turner and law enforcement air support observed him flee into an apartment complex located in the 6000 block of Reflection Drive in San Diego. Officers conducted a search of the complex and Turner was not located. Turner is wanted for various charges, including domestic violence, criminal threats, child endangerment, evading police and violating a domestic violence restraining order.
