Course Description: This five (5) day course is designed to meet certification requirements for Rope Rescue Technician. After completion of this course students will take written and skills test on Chapter 5 and Chapter 6 per NFPA 1006 job performance requirements.

This training will include the participant's ability to evaluate, manage, and perform a technical rope rescue as described by NFPA 1006 & NFPA 1670.

- Compound rope mechanical advantage systems
- Ascending and descending a fixed rope
- Fixed rope systems
- Patient pick-offs
- Highline Systems
- Knot passing
- Litter attendants

Pre-requisite: Low Angle Rope Rescue Operations and Rescue Systems 1 (2009), OR Rescue Systems 1 (prior to 2009) OR Rope Rescue Awareness / Operations

A California State Fire Marshal certificate will be issued by State Fire Training (SFT) and can be accessed on your SFT profile. Maximum of 24 students, minimum of 20 students are needed 7 days prior to start date or it will be cancelled.
