Subject: HOMICIDE – 2700 BLOCK OF FAIVRE STREET, CHULA VISTA ON 3/6/2023

Message: FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On Monday, March 6<sup>th</sup>, 2023, at approximately 11:38 P.M., officers responded to a 9-1-1 call of a disturbance in the 2700 Block of Faivre Street in Chula Vista. Upon arrival, officers located a man with traumatic injuries. Responding medical personnel performed lifesaving measures but the man was pronounced deceased at the scene.

Officers located two men in the area who they believed were involved in the incident. Both had serious injuries which required medical attention. They were transported to a local hospital where they were admitted for treatment. Based on witness statements, both were placed under arrest for murder. One of the men, 18-year-old Yeshua Valenzuela of Chula Vista, was booked into San Diego County Jail early this morning (3/9/2023). The other, 22-year-old Joseph Valenzuela of Chula Vista, remains under guard while receiving medical treatment. The victim has been identified as 43-year-old Marco Cordero of Chula Vista.

Authorities are still investigating the homicide and actively seeking witnesses.
