Subject: SHOOTING – TEEN INJURED – 600 BLOCK W. MANOR DR., CHULA VISTA

Message: FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On Saturday, November 4<sup>th</sup>, at approximately 9:23 p.m., the Chula Vista Police Department received multiple calls of shots heard in the 600 Block of W. Manor Drive in Chula Vista. People were reportedly seen running from the area. Officers responded immediately and contacted several people still in the area. Officers located a 14-year-old male on the ground with multiple gunshot wounds. They began lifesaving measures until medics arrived and took over. The teen was transported to a hospital for treatment. The suspects fled prior to officers arriving.

Officers determined that prior to the shooting there was large party at a house in the 600 Block of W. Manor Drive. The preliminary investigation suggests that the 14-year-old, a resident of San Diego, was leaving the party with a friend when they were confronted by two unknown suspects. During the confrontation, one of the suspects pulled out a firearm and shot the victim multiple times. The suspects then fled the area. No other people were believed to have been injured during the incident.

The victim's gunshot wounds were considered non-life threatening and he is currently in stable condition. His identity is being withheld at this time due to his age. The suspects have not been identified and no additional suspect information is available for release at this time.

Investigators are actively working this case. Based on the number of partygoers, authorities believe there are several witnesses who have not yet spoken with the police. Their cooperation could help identify suspects. They're encouraged to come forward with information and any video evidence they may have.
