A Graduate of Princeton and Stanford Universities, Christine was recognized by the California State Assembly as a "Woman helping Women" and received the Eleanor Roosevelt Human Rights Award from the United Nations Association.

Winner of the American Institute of Architecture Award for Socially Responsive Building, Christine Brady founded the La Esperanza kindergarten, elementary and high schools which offer arts and academic education, and the free binational "More Art = Less Violence" program of Arts and Sports for teens.

A 25 year resident of Chula Vista and proven problem solver, Christine has viable plans for resolving Homelessness in Chula Vista and free transportation for Seniors and Youth in District 4. The homeless proposal includes housing coupled with mental health treatment.

Christine will work to create jobs through a new Arts District, make sure new residences are low cost, spacious and not dependent on street parking, create Trade schools and improve parks, recreation centers and public spaces.

Having worked eight years for the Navy managing large programs, Christine Brady is also committed to fiscal responsibility, making sure Chula Vista's resources are used in programs for the residents and no new taxes are imposed.
