



Minor Construction Permit

Any street improvements within the public right-of-way requires a construction permit per the City of Chula Vista Municipal Code Section 12.20.010

SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS:

Project Submittal Process

Permit fee, Inspection fee, and Traffic Control fee

Amount per Master Fee Schedule (fees to be paid after the completeness review)

Construction Permit Application

Storm Water Intake Form

Construction Cost Estimate (including all work within the public right-of-way)

The construction cost estimate shall be calculated using the most current "City of San Diego Unit Price List for Estimating Permit Bond".

Traffic Control Plans

Any traffic control plans associated with work performed in the public right-of-way must be prepared and stamped by either a "C31" or an "A" Licensed Contractor.

Legibly Drawn Plans

The plans/exhibit must be drawn to scale, fully dimensioned, and reference the City of Chula Vista Construction Standards.

CAL/OSHA Affidavit

Licensed Contractor

The contractor must provide proof of licensing for the proposed work. The following licensed contractors may do work in the City right-of-way:

- Type "A" (Engineering)
- excavation & replacement of asphaltic concrete
- Type "C-8" (Concrete) for concrete work only - Type "C-12" (Paving) for the replacement or
- work, only if they have a valid Building Permit for on-site work

- Type "B" (General) may do street

Submit a copy of the contractor's license and city business license. A city business license is required to do any work within the city.

REQUIRED PRIOR TO ISSUANCE:

A bond in an amount equal to 110% of the approved cost estimate is to be submitted. The bond may be in the form of:

- U.S Currency

- Letter of Credit from a local institution

- Certified Cashier's Check

- City Approved Surety Bond

Certificate of Liability Insurance

The contractor must provide the City with a Certificate of Liability Insurance in the following amount of liability, in accordance with the Green Book (Certificate is to name the City of Chula Vista as the Certificate Holder and Additional Insured):

Bodily Injury:

Property Damage

- \$500,000 each person

- \$250,000 each occurrence

- \$1,000,000 each occurrence

- \$500,000 aggregate

- \$1,000,000 aggregate products

and completed operations

(A combined single limit policy with the aggregate limits in the amount of \$2,000,000 will be considered equivalent to the required minimum)
