Chula Vista, Calif. – On April 20<sup>th</sup>, 2024 the Chula Vista Police Department conducted a driving under the influence (DUI)/Driver's License Checkpoint in the 1500 block of East H Street, City of Chula Vista from 6 p.m. to 12 p.m. The following are the results:

2532 vehicles traveled through the checkpoint.

- 519 vehicles were screened.
- 4 driver's conducted field sobriety tests.
- 2 drivers were arrested for driving under the influence of alcohol and drugs.
- 1 driver was arrested for driving under the influence of marijuana.
- 7 unlicensed or suspended license citations were issued.
- 6 vehicles were impounded.
- 10 total citations were issued.

DUI checkpoint locations are determined based on reported incidents of impaired driving-related crashes. The primary purpose of DUI checkpoints are to promote public safety by taking suspected impaired drivers off roads.

Funding for this checkpoint was provided by a grant from the California Office of Traffic Safety, through the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration.
