### Message:

On May 7<sup>th</sup>, 2024, at approximately 11:43 pm, the Chula Vista Police Department received several calls regarding a two-vehicle traffic collision in the intersection of East Palomar Street and Brandywine Avenue in Chula Vista. Police personnel arrived on scene and discovered the victim, a 3-year-old female was unresponsive. Police and Fire personnel rendered first aid to the child at the scene. Fire personnel transported the child to a trauma center, where they remain in critical condition. The driver remained on scene and after investigation was placed under arrest for DUI related offenses and child endangerment. The second vehicle involved had three female Chula Vista occupants (ages 42, 60 and 69) transported to a local hospital with complaint of pain. The Chula Vista Police Traffic Bureau was called to the scene to investigate the collision.

The driver arrested was 26-year-old female, Ayneisha Bryant Frazier. The names of the victims involved are being withheld for their respective privacy. The cause of the collision has not yet been determined. The Chula Vista Police Traffic Bureau is currently investigating the collision.
