Subject: FATAL INJURY COLLISION - VILLAS DRIVE/VILLAS COURT

Message: FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On Saturday, June 29th, at approximately 12:11 p.m., officers responded to several calls about a single vehicle that had collided with a tree near the intersection of Villas Drive and Villas Court in Bonita. Callers reported possible injuries involved in the collision. Medics arrived at the scene and found a 64-year-old male with serious injuries, still trapped in his vehicle. The driver was freed from the vehicle, and firefighters began lifesaving measures before transporting him to the hospital.

Initial indications suggest that the man was inside a U-Haul truck when it began moving down the hill. The vehicle struck several trees, and the driver was trapped between the door of the U-Haul and a tree. The 64-year-old driver suffered serious injuries and was transported to a local hospital. Upon arrival at the hospital, the driver was pronounced deceased due to the injuries sustained in the collision.

The Chula Vista Police Traffic Bureau is investigating the collision.
