Subject: MAJOR INJURY COLLISION – 1600 block of Wueste Road

Message: FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE

On Sunday, August 4th, at approximately 12:27 p.m., officers responded to several calls of a vehicle that collided with a bicyclist at the 1600 block of Wueste Road in Chula Vista. Callers reported the bicyclist had major injuries. United States Border Patrol officers in the area were first on scene. They provided life saving measures until medics arrived and transported the bicyclist, a 71-year-old man, to a local hospital with major injuries.

The involved vehicle had driven off the roadway after the collision. The driver, a woman in her 30's and resident of Vista, was detained by US Border Patrol officers and subsequently arrested for charges unrelated to the collision. At this time, the cause of the collision is still under investigation, but alcohol is not believed to be a factor.

The Chula Vista Police Traffic Bureau is investigating the collision.
