- TOP AND SIDE "PICKING" TECHNIQUES FOR CENTER OPENING, SIDE OPENING, AND TWO SPEED ELEVATOR DOORS
- ELEVATOR "POLING" AND "DRIFTING" TECHNIQUES
- PATIENT REMOVAL FROM A STALLED ELEVATOR CAR
- ELEVATOR PHASE 1 AND PHASE 2 OPERATIONS
