The Chula Vista Police Department Storefront is located at the Western end of the mall and is currently open to the public Monday through Friday between the hours of 10:00 am and 4:00 pm. The Storefront is typically operated by our Senior Volunteer Patrol Members who provide many services for the public, and occasionally a uniformed Police Officer is also available. The following is a list of typical services the Senior Volunteer Patrol Provides:

The YANA Program: – A program designed for senior and disabled persons who when registered can receive a phone call 6 days a week checking on their well-being.

Vacation Check Program: - A program for homeowners to utilize in which SVP members check on their home daily while the family is away on trips.

Chula Vista Assist: - A program designed to help find adults who have wandered away or become lost.

All these programs are free and to get more information or sign up, please stop by the Storefront location and inquire or call 619 421-2309. At our Storefront location you can also find materials on neighborhood watch, residential burglary, vehicle burglary, and other crime prevention information.

Our SVP members can also assist with fix it tickets; If a citizen receives a ticket that is deemed correctable by an Officer, please visit the Storefront. Nearby residents can save time and energy and avoid going to the Police Department located near Downtown Chula Vista. An example of eligible non-moving violation tickets are as follows:

Vehicle Lighting Violation Window Tint Violation License Plate Violation

At this time we're only able to accept Visa and Mastercard for payment of fix it tickets.
