



Frank Rigley (19.. – 1944)

Frank Rigley listed his state of record as Massachusetts. His wife, Mrs. Lydia Frances Rigley lived at 221 Church Ave, Chula Vista, CA.

Frank Rigley was a Lieutenant in the United States Navy. His service number was 0-017817.

On May 21, 1943, the *Star-News* reported that Lt Frank Rigley, USN of Chula Vista and his wife were entertained at dinner by Mr. and Mrs. Herbert G. Jackson of 81 Second Avenue. Lt Rigley recently returned from the South Pacific where he has been in action since Pearl Harbor for the past 18 months. He was welcomed by his family and friends. Of note, Herbert G. Jackson would also be killed in action in July 1944.

His name appears on the “Tablet of the Missing” in the Honolulu Memorial Cemetery at Honolulu, Hawaii. He is listed as Missing in Action (MIA) or Buried at Sea as of September 13, 1944. His Social Security Number was 551-96-0467 and was obtained in the state of California. A street in the Sunbow Community of Chula Vista honors his name.

He was awarded the Purple Heart.
